

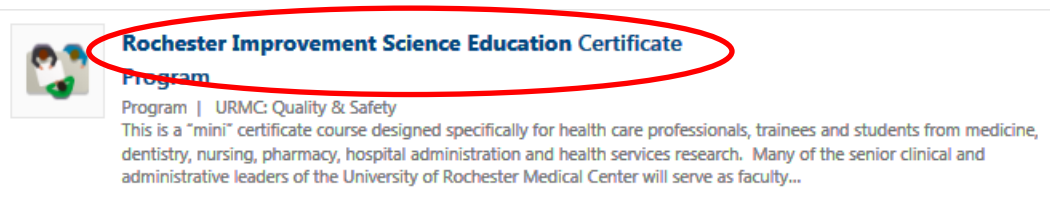

### Rochester Improvement Science Education Certificate Program

Program · URM: Quality & Safety

This is a “mini” certificate course designed specifically for health care professionals, trainees and students from medicine, dentistry, nursing, pharmacy, hospital administration and health services research. Many of the senior clinical and administrative leaders of the University of Rochester Medical Center will serve as faculty for the sessions.

The program is designed to increase your knowledge of how to improve healthcare quality and safety and to educate you on the latest thinking and theories regarding improvement science. The program will consist of eleven individual sessions and will combine presentations and discussion. The program will include leadership’s role in nurturing a culture of high reliability, an understanding of the science of errors and safety, the model for improvement in clinical practice, identification of “measures that matter” in healthcare, teamwork and communication techniques, performance improvement tools, ways to create a safer medication system, the challenges of health literacy and patient diversity, event reporting systems, designing care to maximize value and safety, the impacts of information technology and safety and the business case for safety.
