As a result of the Coronavirus pandemic, the Office of Civil Rights (“OCR”) announced a record number of initiatives to ease the HIPAA requirements and allow for greater response to the pandemic, particularly in regard to use of telehealth platforms. Nevertheless, enforcement activities regarding other HIPAA obligations continued. In addition, cyber-attacks on health care entities flourished as hackers took advantage of opportunities created by the pandemic. This presentation will focus on:

- What the HIPAA requirements are now and how we can expect them to look in the future.
- Compliance with HIPAA requirements that were not altered as a result of the pandemic.
- Preparing for, preventing, and responding to a cyber-attack.
- Managing exposure through vendors.
